



## Carpool Reminders

Thank you for a great start to the school year! Just a friendly reminder of our carpool protocols to ease with the drop off and pick up of students.

#### **AM Carpool**


ENTRY ON THE SCHOOL/CHURCH GROUNDS IN THE MORNING Can be at the light <u>VIA</u>
<u>LINWAY TERRACE AND THE REAR ENTRANCE</u> (BEHIND THE RECTORY). Please do not use the exit ramp to enter onto Linway Terrace. During drop off and pick up this is an exit ramp only.

Cars should line up and drop off students near the front entrance of the school, as close
to the curb as possible. Please do not park in the middle of the driveway to drop off
students. If you need to park your car, please do so in a designated parking spot and
escort your student(s) safely to the entrance.

#### **PM Carpool**

Entry on the School/Church grounds in the afternoon MUST BE via the REAR ENTRANCE (behind the Rectory).

- Kindergarten through 8 -- There are 3 lanes in the parking lot for afternoon pick up. ALL cars picking up students are asked to be in the proper lane as explained below.
- Lane 1 MUST EXIT LEFT on to LINWAY TERRACE. Lane 2 MUST EXIT STRAIGHT to BIRCH ROAD OR LEFT on to OLD DOMINION DRIVE. Lane 3 (the exit ramp lane closest to the school) MUST EXIT RIGHT on to LINWAY TERRACE. Lane 1 is the lane closest to the island, Lane 2 is the middle lane and Lane 3 is the lane closest to the school building.





## Sick Student Protocols and Attendance Procedures

If your child is going to be out sick for the day, a phone call or an email from a parent is required each day(s) of the absence(s) of the student to Mrs. Monica Stilson in the health office at: <a href="mailto:attendance@stjohnacademy.org">attendance@stjohnacademy.org</a>. Mrs. Stilson will communicate the absence with your child's homeroom teacher and coordinate homework (if applicable).

When a student is going to be arriving late, leaving early, or has a change in their pick-up routine, please email Mrs. Monica Stilson in the attendance office: <a href="mailto:attendance@stjohnacademy.org">attendance@stjohnacademy.org</a> and copy Mrs. Gracia Escudero in the front office: <a href="mailto:gescudero@stjohnacademy.org">gescudero@stjohnacademy.org</a> and copy the homeroom teacher.

Just a reminder, that when students leave school during the day due to illness, appointment or any other reason, they must be called for in the School Health Room or the school office. Children may never wait outside the buildings to be picked up during school hours, nor may teachers release a child directly from the classroom.

A note, email, or phone call should be sent to school requesting early dismissal and stating the time and identifying the person who will pick-up the child. Persons picking up a child at a time other than dismissal should report to the school front office and sign the child out. The school staff will call the child in his/her classroom to come to the office to meet the person picking him/her up. Students will not be called in advance to the nurse's office for an early release. Persons picking up a child may not go to the classroom.
