

Trimester 1 Report Cards Going Home This Week

First trimester report cards and MAP® Growth™ test results will be sent home with all students in grades K-8 this week.

Please note the diocese has replaced scantron testing with MAP® Growth™ achievement tests in grades three through seven. Students will be tested three times during the school year in the fall, winter, and spring and a cumulative report will be mailed home at the end of the year with final report cards. These results can be kept at home. Report cards should be signed and returned to your child's homeroom teacher.

Attendance Procedures

When a student is going to be arriving late, leaving early, or has a change in their pick-up routine, please email Mrs. Mrs. Monica Stilson in the attendance office: attendance@stjohnacademy.org and copy Mrs. Gracia Escudero in the front office: gescudero@stjohnacademy.org and copy the homeroom teacher.

Just a reminder, that when students leave school during the day due to illness, appointment or any other reason, they must be called for in the School Health Room or the school office. Children may never wait outside the buildings to be picked up during school hours, nor may teachers release a child directly from the classroom.

A note, email, or phone call should be sent to school requesting early dismissal and stating the time and identifying the person who will pick-up the child. Persons picking up a child at a time other than dismissal should report to the school front office and sign the child out. The school staff will call the child in his/her classroom to come to the office to meet the person picking him/her up. Students will not be called in advance to the nurse's office for an early release. Persons picking up a child may not go to the classroom.
